### **Aventinus Vintage 2003 and 2005**

Aventinus is the world's oldest top-fermenting wheat-doppelbock. It has demonstrated wonderful aging potential. Therefore, the Schneider brewery in Germany decided to age 240 cases of Aventinus each year, with each batch held for a minimum of three years.

**Weltenburger Asam Bock:** - (6.9%) A Doppelbock from Kelheim, Germany

Weltenburg Abbey brewery ([Weltenburger Klosterbrauerei](#)) is the oldest monastery brewery in the world, having been in operation since 1050

**Pinkus Pils:** - (5.2%) An Organic German Pilsner

**Delirium Tremens:** - (8.5%) Nominated as "best beer in the world". Belgium

**Chimay Blue:** - (9%) A Belgian Strong Ale

**Maredsous 10:** - (10%) An Abbey Tripel from Belgium

**Samuel Smiths Organic Cider:** (5%) A Cider from England

**Guinness:** - (4.2%) A dry Stout from Ireland

**Dogfish Head IPA 90 minute:** - (9%) An Imperial Double IPA from Delaware

**Abita Restoration Ale:** – This beer is dedicated to the restoration of the New Orleans area

**Yards Pale Ale:** - (4.3%) American Pale Ale from Philly

**Lancaster Oktoberfest:** A seasonal Lager from Lancaster, PA

**Cricket Hill Fall Festivus Ale:** - (5.1%) A Premium Bitter from New Jersey
